

Agreement made this 3^d day of October 1860 between
Michael M. Brayman, & George R. Brayman of the Town
& County of Chautauque New York.

The above named Michael M. Brayman, having this
day made & executed his last will & testament, devising
his real estate as therein mentioned, to the said George, now
therefor in consideration of the agreement hereinafter men-
tioned on the part of the said George, I do hereby agree to
& with the said George, that I will not revoke or change the
said will, or in case that I should do so. that the said
George should be paid for his services rendered from
the time he came to live with me, until he shall leave,
such sum as shall be considered just & reasonable, by
three men to be selected one by me, one by said George &
the third, by the two thus chosen - and also for all payment
& advance made by him for me during the time aforesaid.

The above named George Brayman, in consideration
of the foregoing hereby agrees to & with the said Michael
M. Brayman that he will, with his wife, live with, pro-
vide for & take care of the said Michael & his wife
for & during the term of their natural lives, in a proper &
comfortable manner, during sickness & health so as best
to promote their welfare & happiness -

And it is mutually agreed that the farm owned by the
said Michael shall be occupied, improved & cultivated
by the said George, & the proceeds applied to the support
& maintenance of both families, but the control &
ownership shall remain in said Michael during
his life, so that he shall never be deprived of his home
without his own act in the sale & disposition thereof.
