

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT WE, Conrad Schilling  
George Weigand and Elijah Lehnert

ARE HELD AND FIRMLY BOUND to pay to the **STATE OF OHIO**, the full sum of

Five hundred Dollars, if default be made in the condition following:

The condition hereof is such, that whereas, Letters of Administration on the estate of John Kelly  
deceased, were granted to the said Conrad Schilling

by the COURT OF PROBATE of Tuscarawas County, and State of Ohio, on the 20 day of June

A. D. 1861; Now if the said, Conrad Schilling as Administrator of the said

John Kelly deceased: 1st, shall make and return to the said Court, on oath, within three

months, a true Inventory of all the moneys, goods, chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, which are by law to be administered,

and which shall come to his possession or knowledge; and, also, if required by the said Court, an Inventory of the

real estate of said deceased: 2ndly, shall administer, according to law, all moneys, goods, chattels, rights and credits of the said

deceased, and the proceeds of all his real estate, that may be sold for the payment of his debts, which shall, at

any time, come to the possession of said Administrator, or to the possession of any other person for him: 3dly,

shall render upon oath a true account of his administration within eighteen months, and at any other times, when requi-

red by said Court or the law: 4thly, shall pay any balance remaining in his hands upon the settlement of his

accounts, to such person as the Court or the law shall direct: and 5thly, shall deliver the Letters of Administration into Court, in

case any will of said deceased shall be hereafter duly proven and allowed. Then, but in no otherwise, shall this obligation be null

and void.
