Appointement of Administrator.

This cause came up for hearing on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1885 on petition of Matthew Carroll praying that Letters of Administration issue to him on the estate of Peter Carroll. It appears from said petition that Peter Carroll late a resident of Dubuque County died at Masoville in Delaware County Iowa on or about the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October 1885 intestate that he left surviving him no widow, but did leave the following named heirs at law:

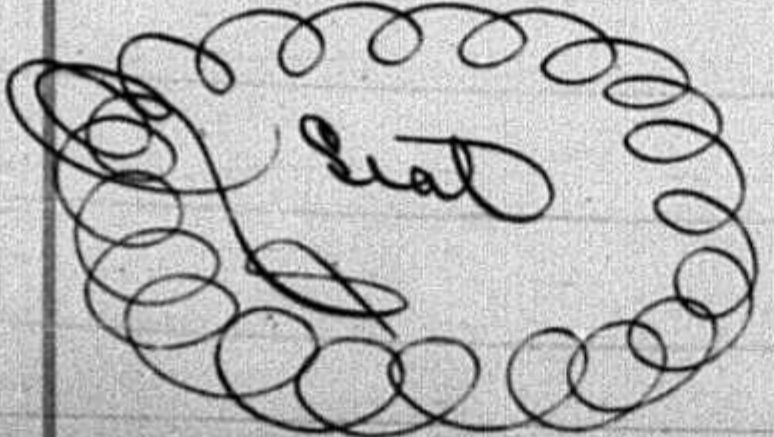
Matthew Carroll aged 43 years Owen Carroll aged 40 years

and all residents of the State of Iowa, that he died seized of the following described real estate: The N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Sec 26. Tp 28. Range 1 West and 3/4 South West 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec 25 - Tp 29 - R. 1. W. Containing in all 110 acres and also personal property of the value of \$500. That petitioner is a son of deceased.

And said petition being examined by the Court, said Matthew Carroll is appointed Administrator of the Estate of Peter Carroll deceased upon filing bonds in the penal sum of \$1000. with surety to be approved by the Clerk of this Court. And he is ordered to publish notice of his appointment in the Dubuque Herald for three weeks
