### Death of Peter Carroll.

Peter Carroll of Taylor township and old resident of Dubuque county, died at Masonville on the 13th of October while on a visit to his son Owen Carroll of that place. He was a native of Ireland and emigrated to the United States in 1830, and located at Steubenburg, Ohio, where he remained until 1857, when he moved to this state, settling in Iowa township and afterwards

in Taylor township, which had been his residence up to the time of his death. He lived to be 72 years old. Of his family who survive him, are his sons James, of Cascade; Mathew, and daughter Mrs. Freeman, of Taylor township, and Owen, of Masonville.

The funeral took place at St. Joseph's church, Farley, the Rev. Slattery officiating.
