Notes: This is the Carroll family as of the 1885 state census. They has arrived in Colorado about 1878 or 79. The father Patrick had passed away between 1877 and 1880. We do not know if it was in Kansas or Colorado. Anna and 4 of her children lived on 641 Waverly St. in Denver. Annie would pass away in 1895 from heart disease and is buried in Mt Olivetet Cemetery in Denver. Almost everyone worked to support the family. Mary (the oldest) was a cook/servant to the Tucker family who lived on nearby Glenarm. Thomas (later known by our generations as Grandpa Carroll) was already into his chosen profession of printing in which he would be engaged his whole life. At this time Irene Martin, his future wife is living with her aunt Bridget Dohney and her family along with her other aunt who is 14 year old Nellie McNamera. * It is unclear why it shows Mo. for Mary's birth. All other records point to Kansas.
