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THIS INDENTURE, made this 20th day of March, 1959, between VALHALLA PROPERTIES, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, party of the first part, hereinafter called the Grantor, and Richard W. Denaple and Ruby L. Denaple, as joint tenants of 11023 Kling St., No. Hollywood, California party of the second part, hereinafter called the Grantee;

WITNESSETH:

That the Grantor, in consideration of the sum of TEN dollars (\$ 10.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant to Richard W. Denaple and Ruby L. Denaple its heirs and assigns forever, as a place of burial for the dead the use of Crypt No. D-8, inside, Unit No. 4 of the Garden Crypts in VALHALLA MAUSOLEUM PARK, a cemetery situated upon a portion of Lot A Tract 7341, as shown upon a map of said Lot and Tract recorded in the office of the county recorder of the county of Los Angeles, State of California, in book 77, at page 90 of maps.

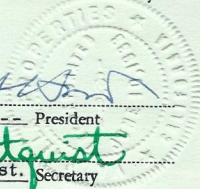
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the use of said Crypt to the said Grantee, its heirs and assigns forever, subject, however, to any public laws, ordinances or regulations enforceable in the premises, and to the rules and regulations of the VALHALLA MAUSOLEUM PARK and VALHALLA MEMORIAL PARK, now in force, or which may hereafter be adopted by the said corporation which rules are specifically made a part hereof. Transfer or sale of the Crypt or Crypts referred to herein shall not be valid without the written approval of and the registration with said VALHALLA PROPERTIES, and should any transfer be made in violation of this restriction, title to said crypt or crypts shall revert to VALHALLA PROPERTIES.

There has been deposited the sum of Sixty-five dollars (\$ 65.00) in the Endowment Care Fund to be invested as authorized by law with other funds of like character the income derived therefrom to be used in the Endowment care and protection of said MAUSOLEUM in accordance with rules and regulations of VALHALLA MAUSOLEUM PARK AND VALHALLA MEMORIAL PARK.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said VALHALLA PROPERTIES has caused its corporate name to be signed and its corporate seal affixed hereto by its proper officers thereunto duly authorized, this 20th day of March, 1959.
