

# LINCOLN PLANT READY TO RUN

**Machine Drill Will Begin on Ore  
Body—Crude to Be Shipped  
While Mill Is Built.**

The installation of a three-drill compressor was completed last week on the Crystal mine of the Lincoln Mining and Milling company, in the mountains of Lincoln county, north of Davenport. It is expected to be in operation soon.

"In the course of the development that is to proceed, the workings will enter a large body of ore, considerable of which will be of a shipping grade," said Luke C. Williams, a trustee, yesterday. "It is proposed to begin shipments prior to completion of the mill as it will be necessary to remove ore in development. In the meantime, the ore of a milling grade will be stored.

"Some of the better grade of ore removed by prospectors contained 20 to 25 per cent lead and more than an ounce of silver to the per cent of lead. Some of the best lead contained more than 71 per cent, 61 ounces of silver and \$12.14 in copper to the ton."

The development and equipment is in charge of R. N. Denaple, who is also a trustee.
