

# Expert, Novice 'Cyclists Vie in Gardena Tonight

Carrell Speedway's road-type motorcycle race meet tonight divides riders into expert and novice groups for the first time this season, giving the latter an equal shot at purse money. Trials open at 7 p. m. followed by races at 8:30 p. m.
