THE EXECUTOR OF THE WILL OF THE LATE JUDGE ABRAHAM SAWELL, OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF MASSACHUSETTS, DOETHHOLD, AND TO THE SEVERAL CREDITORS OF SAID ESTATE, I, THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE SAID BOND HAS BEEN FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT, AND THAT THE SAID BOND IS VALID AND EFFECTIVE AS TO THE SAID ESTATE.

therein named; then present *Joseph H. Hovey* one of the
