Know all men by these presents that John Heath of the County of Fulton and State of Illinois in Consideration of One hundred and Seventy Dollars some paid by Samuel Heath of the same County and State the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Heath his heirs and assigns the following goods and chattels to wit, One Bay Horse Eight year Old one Grey horse seven years Old one two horse wagon some Colored top running gears faded red being the same horses and wagon owned by me at the signing of these presents I do have and do hold all and singular the said goods and Chattels unto the said Samuel Heath his heirs and assigns forever Provided nevertheless That if the said John Heath shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Samuel Heath his heirs or assigns the sum of One hundred and forty Dollars according to the tenor of two notes for 70.00 each due one year after date payable to the said Samuel Heath or Order bearing even date here with then this mortgage is to be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect And Provided further That until default made by the said John Heath in the performance of the Condition aforesaid it shall and may be lawful for him to retain the possession of the said goods and chattels and to use and enjoy the same but if the same or any part thereof shall be attached or claimed by any other person or persons at any time before payment of the above sum of money according to the tenor of two notes aforesaid before or after the same shall become due or the said John Heath shall attempt to sell the same without the authority and permission of the said Samuel Heath or his assigns in writing or printed then it shall and may be lawful for the said Samuel Heath his heirs or assigns to take immediate and full possession of the whole of the said goods and chattels to have and to use In witness whereof the said John Heath has hereunto set his hand and seal this tenth day of June A D 1854
