To all to whom these presents shall, Greeting:

Homestead Certificate No. 7357

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Wichita Kansas, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain", and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of John Heath has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the

South West quarter of the South East quarter and the South half of the South West quarter of Section eight and the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section seven, in Township twenty six South of Range four East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Wichita, Kansas containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said John Heath the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John Heath and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the twentieth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy five and of the Independence of the United States the one hundredth.
