

Road Notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, THAT A PETITION was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Butler county, Kansas, at their meeting begun and held on the 12th day of April, 1886, praying for the appointment of viewers to view a route for a highway, to be located along the following points, to-wit:

Beginning at the nw cor of sec 6, 27, 4, thence e one mile and about 145 rds thence around the bend in the branch thence e on the twp line to Whitewater river thence s along the river about 25 rds to old ford thence across and n to twp line, thence e on twp line to nw cor of ne $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 4, 27, 4, to be located on or as near the aforesaid line as practicable.

And that the said Board of County Commissioners did on the 13th day of April, 1886, appoint Dan Cupp, George Estis and John Heath viewers to view and lay out a road on the route prayed for as above described, and did order that they, the said viewers, be notified to meet at the place of beginning on the 28th day of May, 1886, at 9 o'clock a. m. and to proceed, together with the County Surveyor, to examine said route as above required, and that they then and there give all persons interested a proper hearing, and make their report as the law directs, to this office.
