Intent to Become a Citizen

27 September 1859

BE IT REMEMBERED, That on this *Twenty seven* day of *August* Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine *Levin Reiter* an alien, being duly sworn before the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for the county aforesaid, according to law, declares and says:

That he was born in *Wittenberg Prussia* on the *Thirteenth* day of *June* A. D., 1826 whence he emigrated, and arrived at the port of *New York* in the United States, on the *Eighteenth* day of *October* A. D. 1855 and that it is bona fide his intention to become a CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, and to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to *William King of Wattenberg* of whom he is now a subject.
