Col. 1. VALUE OF HOME, IF OWNED: Where owner's household occupies only a part of a structure...  
Col. 2. COLOR OR RACE: White, Negro, Indian, Chinese, Japanese, Other race, spell out in full.  
Col. 3. AGE AT LAST BIRTHDAY: Enter age of children born on or after April 1, 1938, as follows.  
Col. 4. HIGHEST GRADE OF SCHOOL COMPLETED: None, Elementary school, High school, College.  
Col. 5. CITIZENSHIP OF THE FOREIGN BORN: Naturalized, Baring first papers, Alien, American citizen born abroad.  
Col. 6. WAS THIS PERSON AT WORK? Enter "Yes" for person at work for pay or profit in private or semi-government work...
