

Memorandum that on the twenty Sixth Day of  
 October in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven hundred and  
 Sixty two, John Rider and Simon Rider both of the Oblong in Dutchess  
 County and Province of New York, ~~do~~ mortgaged us to Daniel  
 Gomez of the City of New York Merchant, All that Certain Tract  
 or Parcel of Land situate lying and being in Dutchess County  
 Aforeward being part of that tract of Land called the Oblong or  
 Equivalent.

**Equivalent** Land known and distinguished by the name of **the N. Nine Beginning**, at the South East Corner of said Lot near the Dwelling house of one Benjamin Sears and from thence running North two Degrees and thirty minutes East seventy two Chains and an half and from thence West twelve Degrees and thirty Minutes north thirty six Chains and a Quarter and from thence South twelve Degrees and thirty minutes West seventy two Chains and an half and from thence East twelve Degrees and thirty minutes South thirty six Chains and a Quarter to the first Station Containing Two hundred and fifty Acres **To have and to hold** let

For Securing the Payment of two severall certain bonds or Writings Obligatory under their hands and Seals duly Exposed bearing Dates the first Day of May in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and sixty one and the first Day of June in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty two, by which the said John Rider and Simon Rider are jointly and severally Bound unto the said Daniel Gomez in the Penal sum of Nine hundred Pounds Equal to Spanish Dollars at Eight Shillings each as they Passed at the Date time of the Dates of the before said Bonds, with Conditions severally under the said bonds written firstly that if the John Rider and Simon Rider and each of their Heirs Executors Administrators or any of them Shall and Do Well and truly Pay or Cause to be paid unto the above named Daniel Gomez or to his Certain Attorney Executors Administrators or Assigns the just and full sum of two hundred Pounds equal to Spanish Dollars as aforesaid on or before the first Day of May then Next after the Date of the first dated Bond aforesaid together with the Lawfull Interest thereof that then said first dated Bond to be void or else to remain in full Force secondly that if the above named John Rider and Simon Rider their Heirs Executors or Administrators or any of them Shall and Do Well and truly Pay or Cause to be paid unto the above named Daniel Gomez or to his Certain Attorney Executors Administrators or Assigns the just and full sum of two hundred and fifty Pounds equal to Spanish Dollars as aforesaid together with Lawfull Interest on the same on or before the first Day of June next ensuing the Date of the last aforesaid Dated Bond that then the last mentioned Bond to be void, but, or Else to remain in full Force and Virtue as by the said Bonds and Conditions thereunder Relation
