

BURTON L. RIDER BADLY INJURED

Hurt In Fall From Barn Near
Utica Thursday.

CHADWICKS, June 7.—Falling 12 feet from a scaffolding on a barn which he was re-roofing, Burton L. Rider, 72, 150 West Eighth street, Oswego, is in a critical condition in Faxton Hospital, Utica.

He is suffering from a fractured skull and a crushed chest.

The mishap took place Thursday morning on the farm of his brother, Elmer E. Rider, located on the Roberts road, about two miles from this village.

The W. H. Fisk ambulance was called and the man was taken to the hospital.

Mr. Rider, who is a carpenter by occupation, left Oswego one week ago for Chadwicks to assist his brother in roofing the barn. He had just started work when the accident happened. Mrs. Rider left Thursday afternoon for Chadwicks.

Mr. Rider is a Spanish War veteran, serving with the 48th Separate Company.
