Remarks: On Nov. 22, 1852, in Original Book 19, page 274, Highland County Deed Records, Thomas L. ROGERS and Mary Jane his wife conveyed to Isaac COLVIN 133-2/3 acres "saving therefrom for the burying ground 1/3 of an acre". Only two monuments could be found on a little hill or rise in the field behind the farm house.
