Tractor Accident in Big Hole Fatal to Charles Shepherd, 56

Charles Shepherd, 56, widely known Big Hole Valley ditch rider, trapper, and ranch worker, was killed Saturday afternoon when a tractor loader he was operating overturned, pinning him underneath while he was repairing an irrigation canal about 14 miles west of Wisdom.

According to reports received by Sheriff Lloyd Thomas, Shepherd and Lee Chestnut, an employee of the Hirschy Ranch, were replacing a washed-out spillway when the accident occurred. Shepherd was believed to have been driving the loader up a steep bank when it overturned. Chestnut was unable to extricate him and rushed to Wisdom for assistance. He apparently died within minutes of the mishap.

A native of Kansas, Shepherd was born June 16, 1908, and had been employed in the big Hole area for the past 35 years. He had never married.
