

LIST FOR FORT RILEY

THIS DRAFT BUNCH GOES WEEK
OF JULY 22

About Three Hundred Men Will Be
Called and Class One Will Be
Exhausted By This
Demand

V. H. Forney, clerk of the local draft board, said today that the call for the week beginning July 22 will take all the men in the county remaining in Class One. Notice was received today that thirty-seven men, not including the 227 who are to leave the week of July 22, would have to be called to take the place of twenty-five men who were rejected from the last two calls, because of physical disability and twelve who did not answer the last call.

Mr. Forney said that he would call between 275 and 300 men in order to be sure that the desired number would report for service.
