Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and *thirty-one*

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That whereas the above-bounden *Jonas Underwood* has
this day taken upon *himself* the office of Executor to the last will and testament of *Reuben Underwood*
late of *Spencer* in the County of Worcester, deceased,
and thereby the burthen of paying *his* debts and legacies, together with the charges of settling the estate:

Now, therefore, if the said *Jonas Underwood* his heirs, executors, or administrators, or
any of them, do well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, the said deceased's debts and legacies, and in all matters the same
concerning, faithfully fulfil the said deceased's will, and administer *his* estate according thereunto, and render, upon oath,
an account of *his* proceedings thereupon, when thereunto lawfully required; then the above-written Obligation to be void,
